Buxton Share Shop Policy

The Buxton Share Shop is located in the Transfer Station's recycling building. The Share Shop or "Buxton Mall" is a great place to leave unwanted items or find new treasures. The Share Shop promotes the reuse of toys, books, and other items in good condition. Please do not leave dirty or broken items in the share shop. Bulky items in good condition may be left outside near the bike rack for reuse. Please ask us before taking anything from the outside areas. Children are welcome but must be supervised in all areas of the Transfer Station. Shirts and shoes must be worn, no bare feet allowed.

The Transfer Station will charge a fee for items brought to the Share Shop unless those items can be recycled if no one takes them. Fees will be determined at the discretion of the gate attendant or management. Items accepted for free include books, puzzles, magazines, glassware, dishes, pottery, ceramics, and anything that is at least 50% metal by weight that doesn't contain freon, propane, or other pressurized gas. Some items in "like new" condition may be accepted at a discounted fee if they are considered certain to be taken. Computers, monitors, televisions, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, refrigerators, freezers, water coolers, propane tanks, and tires cannot be accepted for free for the Share Shop regardless of their condition. We do not accept clothing for the Share Shop.

Items from the Share Shop are not meant to be taken for resale. Professional scavengers are banned from the share shop. It is not our intent to be a supplier for yard sales or flea markets. We reserve the right to restrict who takes items from the share shop. We also reserve the right to restrict the number and type of items taken by any particular individual, and to limit the amount of time spent at the Share Shop. Anyone caught breaking the rules will be banned from the Share Shop.

The Share Shop is for Buxton Residents only. You may be asked for ID to confirm that you are a Buxton resident. The Town of Buxton assumes no liability for items taken from the Share Shop. All items taken are "as is" at your own risk. An electrical outlet is available to test electrical items. We recommend testing all electrical items before taking them home. We don't keep track of who takes what from the Share Shop, so items taken from the Share Shop that are returned to us will incur a charge unless they can be recycled.

The Share Shop closes 15 minutes before the Transfer Station closes. Hours: Tuesday, Thursday, & Saturday 8am - 3:45pm.
